

INTERNATIONAL STAFF TRAVEL TO CAMP

The international staff agencies (Camp America, Camp Counselor USA, IENA CIEE, etc.) are responsible for organizing your flight to the United States to be coordinated with our expectations for your arrival at William Lawrence Camp.

Staff from Europe, South Africa and South America fly into Boston. Staff from Australia and New Zealand fly into Los Angeles.

IMPORTANT!!!! You will be applying for a Social Security card. We will take care of that after you arrive at camp. You are NOT to take public transportation such as a bus or train to camp.

If you are flying directly into Boston, please have your flight arrive by 12pm on the same day that you are expected to arrive at camp.

If you are coming from the west coast, you must book a flight to Manchester, New Hampshire or Boston, Massachusetts for the same day that you are expected to arrive at camp. Please have your flight arrive in the early/late afternoon. Camp personnel will pick you up in Manchester or Boston. First-time international staff coming from Australia and New Zealand are responsible for all travel costs to Manchester or Boston.

RETURNING STAFF: please bear in mind that we will be able to pick you up from Manchester or Boston ONLY, so plan accordingly.
